Nehemiah 4:13-14

*Therefore I stationed some of the people behind the lowest points of the wall at the exposed places, posting them by families, with their swords, spears and bows. After I looked things over, I stood up and said to the nobles, the officials and the rest of the people, "Don't be afraid of them. Remember the Lord, who is great and awesome, and fight for your brothers, your sons and your daughters, your wives and your homes."*

- Training Focus: *Emergency Code*

### **9-1-1**

- - What it means when Mom or Dad yell "9-1-1"

- Training Focus: *Home Invasion*

- - What to do if bad guys are trying to break into the house
- - Designate a Safe Room
- - Practice calling 911 for emergencies

- Training Focus: *Keeping our Castle Secure*

- - Locking doors and windows
- - Keeping the dog(s) happy and trained
- - Being observant of whats going on in the neighborhood
- - Not opening doors for strangers (what is a stranger?)

- Training Focus: *Self Defense*

- - Krav Maga and Kung Fu
- - Observe Surroundings and be Aware
- - ie. Loose Dogs

- Action Steps:

- - Practice securing the house (lock doors and windows, etc)
- - Practice a home invasion
- - Locate and identify emergency phone, first aid kit, home defense (guns, bows, etc)
